

Tamalpais HS Solar Project Construction & Temporary Parking Information



Temporary Parking Information for Fall Semester 2023: (as of June 2023)

During the summer of 2023, two solar carport structures will be constructed in the Miller Avenue Parking Lot. These structures will support 454 solar panels with 8 EV car-charging stations to reduce our carbon footprint; provide energy savings and increase energy capacity for planned classroom air-conditioning. Overall, the solar canopies are expected to produce 0.411 megawatts (MW) annually which will save TUHSD approximately \$116,000 per year in energy costs.

The solar project is in the final stage and under review with the Department of the State Architect (DSA) before construction may begin. Following DSA approval, construction is anticipated to start during the 2023 fall semester (tentatively August through December 2023) which will close the Miller Avenue Parking Lot. Miller's closure will impact both student and staff parking (Almonte Avenue Parking Lot), however, a temporary parking lot will be constructed in late Summer to provide 74 of the current 83 staff parking spaces. This temporary change will result in 9 fewer parking spaces for staff during construction (see photo below for location).

Additionally, in early August—prior to the start of school—Tam High's administration will provide guidance on traffic flow and assigned student parking spaces during the 2023-24 school year.
