

SCHEDULING TIPS FOR JUNIOR YEAR

All students must take six classes. A seventh class (elective) is optional. If you elect to enroll in six courses, then you must also select “No 1st period” or “No 7th period” for each semester which can be found in the courses listed under “Non Departmental”. **Note:** We cannot guarantee that you will get No 1st Period or No 7th Period off.

You will automatically be enrolled in the required junior year courses:

- Social Studies: US History
- Math (your current math teacher will do this for you)
- Chemistry in the Earth System

English: All English courses are yearlong, either AP or pairings (fall/spring). Please make sure that you also request alternates as your first request is not guaranteed.

Social Studies: If electing AP US History instead of US History, select AP US History and uncheck US History.

Math: Math will be selected for you by your current math teacher.

Science: Advanced Algebra is required for Physics.

World Language: Two years is required by almost all universities. Three or more years is recommended by many.

Fine Arts: One year is required for graduation and college entrance.

Final placement in Advanced Placement/Honors courses depends on meeting course entrance requirements. Please review the [AP/Honors Informational Matrix](#)

Choose your electives and **alternates** carefully. The classes you choose cannot be changed next school year. Listing **at least two alternates** increases the likelihood of your schedule matching your interests.

You cannot select Peer Resource or Leadership because there is an application process. You must select another elective course you will take in case you are not accepted.
